This constraint only allowed us to gain basic knowledge of each tool, which proved insufficient for practical industry applications. It becomes difficult to master all of them in such a short period. I believe that focusing on in-depth training in any one specific tool would be more beneficial for students. Mastering a single tool would better prepare students for placements and provide them with a strong, marketable skill set. This approach would help students feel more confident and competent in their chosen field.

4. Do you have any suggestions for enhancing our academic curriculum? Specifically, which subjects or areas do you think could significantly benefit the juniors in terms of career advancement and skill enhancement?

Similar to the approach for IT students, other students should also focus on mastering one core skill set to enhance their capabilities. This focused approach will help in building strong, marketable skills and better prepare them for future opportunities.

5. What would you like to advise the college to undertake in order to equip the students well for this dynamic professional world?

To ensure student success, GIMS integrates an industry-relevant curriculum by regularly updating it to reflect the latest trends and technologies, and by partnering with leading companies, industry experts, and alumni to offer practical insights and real-world projects.
