

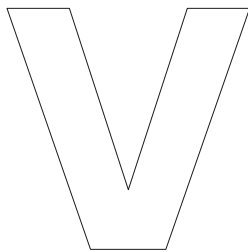

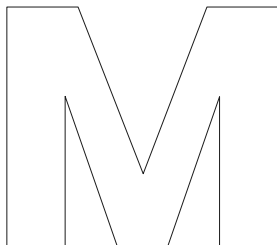
Vision & Mission of the Institute

To become a widely acclaimed management school contributing towards management education and research for developing

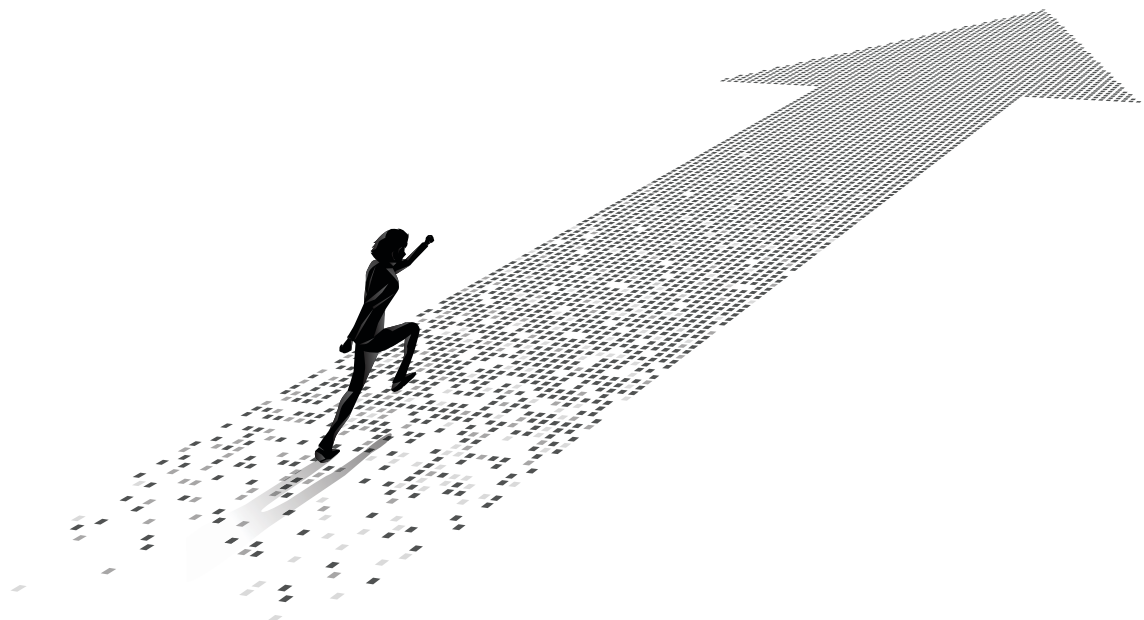

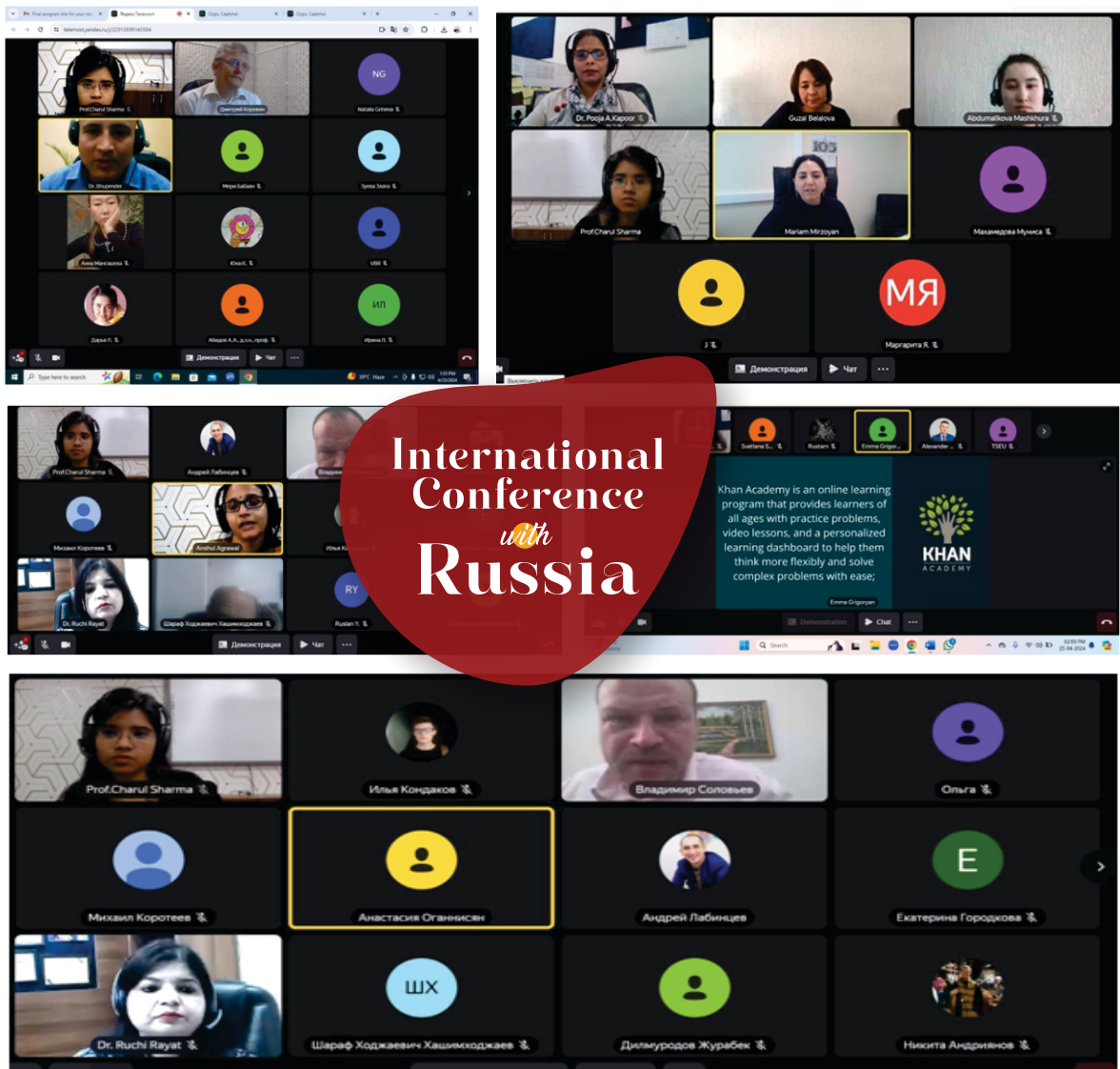
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INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

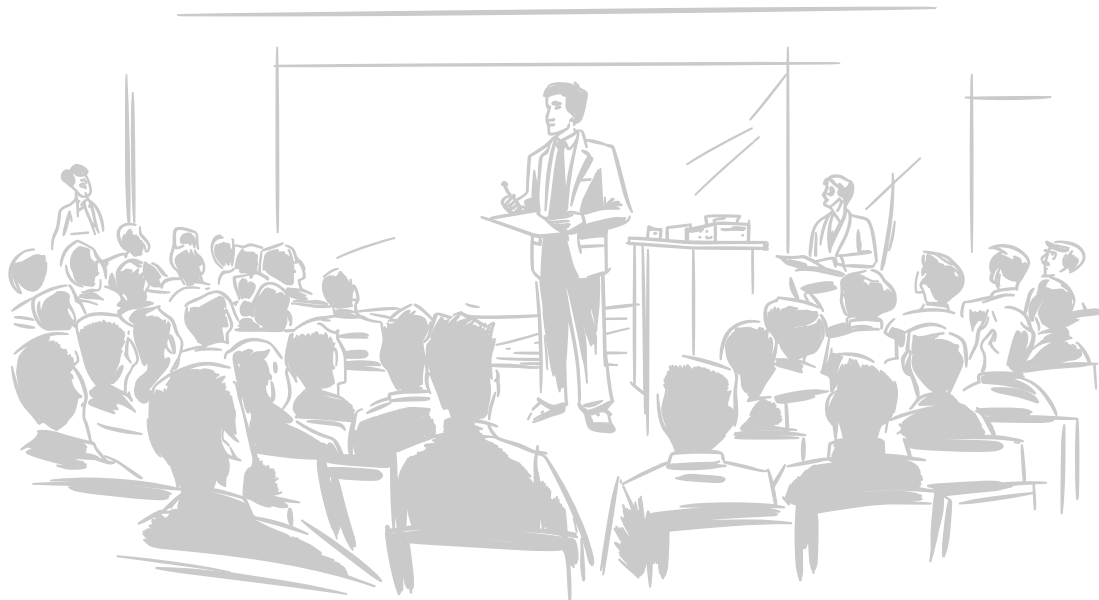

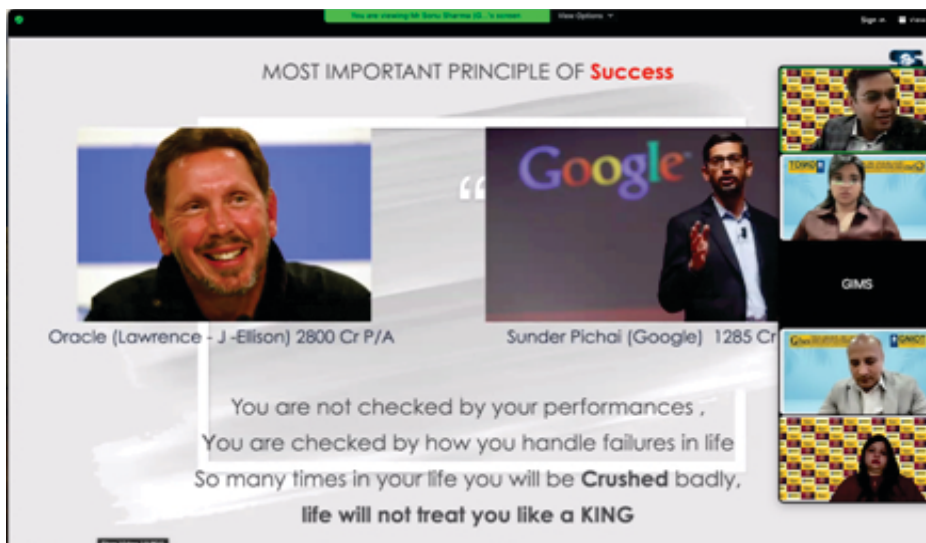
